EVENT OVERVIEW

- Dates: July 31 - August 2, 2025
- Location: Utah State Fairpark
- Format: 5v5 street soccer (4 field players + 1 goalkeeper)
- Roster Size: 5 minimum, 9 maximum
- Divisions: Boys & Girls, birth years 2007-2018 (high school bracket possible)
- Entry Fee: \$450 per team
- Registration Deadline: July 24
- Games Guaranteed: 3 minimum - possible 4th for championship

GAMEPLAY RULES & FORMAT

Game Duration

- 2 halves of 22 minutes each
- 2-minute halftime
- No overtime in group stage

Equipment Rules

- Footwear: Flat-soled indoor, futsal, or turf shoes only - no cleats allowed
- Shin guards required
- Matching shirts preferred (pinnies provided if needed)

Gameplay Restrictions

- No offside

- No slide tackles
- Headers are allowed

Restart Rules

- Out of bounds (sideline): Pass-ins only (no throw-ins)
- Corner kicks: Awarded when the defending team knocks the ball over their own endline
- No goal kicks: If the attacking team puts the ball over the endline, play resumes with the keeper in possession
- Goalkeeper distribution:
 - No punts allowed
 - Throws or drop-kicks must bounce before crossing midfield
 - Keeper may not send the ball in the air over half without a bounce

Scoring & Advancement

- Win: 3 points
- Draw: 1 point
- Loss: 0 points

Tiebreaker Order:

1. Head-to-Head result
2. Goal Differential
3. Goals Scored
4. Goals Against
5. Coin Toss

AWARDS

- Medals for 1st and 2nd place teams in each division

VENUE INFORMATION

- Outdoor concrete playing surfaces
- Music, food trucks, and vendor tents throughout the event
- Family-friendly environment

PARKING

- Paid parking available inside the venue
- Free parking available in surrounding areas

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Team managers must submit roster with player names and birth years
- All players required to sign a waiver prior to participation
